

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CLAY COUNTY ELECTION BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2015-2 VOTE CENTER PLAN AMENDMENT #1

Whereas, the Clay County Vote Center Plan was duly adopted on January 29, 2014; and,

Whereas, Indiana Code 3-11-18.1-15 authorizes Clay County to amend a plan adopted with a county election board's order under I.C. 3-11-18.1-3 by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the board approving the plan amendment; and,

Whereas, the Clay County Election Board has determined certain amendments be made to the Clay County Vote Center Plan in regards to the execution of Municipal Elections within Clay County,

Whereas, the Clay County Election Board so approves the Clay County plan amendment for vote centers in Clay County, Indiana.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE CLAY COUNTY ELECTION BOARD;

EQUIPMENT/TECHNOLOGY

Distribution of Voting Machines

Clay County currently has 72 MicroVote Infinity DRE Voting machines. As in recent years, two (2) of these machines will be used in the Clay County Election Office for Absentee Voting. The distribution of the remaining voting machines will be as follows:

Federal Election Years

- 8 Voting Machines – All Vote Centers open on Election Day
- 3 Voting Machines – Satellite Absentee Voting locations (same machines used on both Saturdays)

Municipal Election Years

- 8 Voting Machines – At each of the Brazil Vote Center Locations (Primary and General)
- 6 Voting Machines – At each of the Towns required to conduct a Municipal General Election (and Primary if so resolved by the respective town board).
- 3 Voting Machines – Satellite Absentee Voting locations (same machines used on both Saturdays)

POLL WORKERS

On Election Day for Federal Elections (even-numbered years), all Vote Centers will be staffed by nine (9) poll workers. This includes one (1) Inspector (Currently Republican, pending future Secretary of State results), four (4) Poll Clerks (2 Republican, 2 Democrat) and four (4) Judges

(2 Republican, 2 Democrat) who shall be selected by the chairman of their respective parties and participate in subsequent poll worker training provided by Clay County. Lack of participation in poll worker training will result in removal of that individual from being a poll worker for that election. Clay County hopes to also have alternates available, who have also completed training, in the event of illness/emergency on or prior to Election Day.

On Election Day for Municipal Elections, all Vote Centers will be staffed by five (5) poll workers. This includes one (1) Inspector (Currently Republican, pending future Secretary of State results), two (2) Poll Clerks (1 Republican, 1 Democrat) and two (2) Judges (1 Republican, 1 Democrat) who shall be selected by the chairman of their respective parties and participate in subsequent poll worker training provided by Clay County. Lack of participation in poll worker training will result in removal of that individual from being a poll worker for that election. Clay County hopes to also have alternates available, who have also completed training, in the event of illness/emergency on or prior to Election Day.

The Clay County Election Board adopts this Order to approve the Clay County Vote Center ^{an} amendments.

Further, this resolution shall take effect immediately and may only be rescinded or modified by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the Clay County Election Board.
