

Whereas, the Floyd County Vote Center Plan was duly adopted on October 10, 2012; and,

Whereas, Indiana Code 3-11-18.1-15 authorizes Floyd County to amend a plan adopted with a county election board's order under I.C. 3-11-18.1-3 by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the board approving the plan amendment; and,

Whereas, the Floyd County Election Board has determined that two vote center locations need to be changed. The locations were approved during the Floyd County Commissioner's regular meeting of June 18, 2013; and,

Whereas, the Floyd County Election Board would also add Mobile Vote Centers to be used at health care facilities and/or any location deemed necessary by unanimous approval of the Election Board; and

Whereas, the Floyd County Election Board so approves the Floyd County plan amendment for vote centers in Floyd County, Indiana.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE FLOYD COUNTY ELECTION BOARD;

The vote center locations shall be as follows:

The following are vote center locations to be open on Election Days from 6:00 am – 6:00 pm. Vote Center number 9, John Jones Automotive will be the only vote center open for the November 5th, 2013 Town of Greenville Special Election from 6:00 am-6:00 pm




Further, this resolution shall take effect immediately and may only be rescinded by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the Floyd County Election Board



FLOYD COUNTY ELECTION BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2013-02

ESTABLISHING DATE AND HOURS FOR IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING
FOR SPECIAL ELECTION

Recitals

Whereas, a certain number of voters will vote in the November 5, 2013 special election in Town of Greenville, Floyd County by absentee in the office of the circuit court clerk before an absentee voter board pursuant IC 3-11-10-26;

Whereas, the Floyd County Election Board desires to enact a resolution to set days and hours for absentee voting in the office of the circuit court clerk before an absentee voter board pursuant to IC 3-11-10-26.5

Findings of Fact

Now, therefore, in support of this resolution, the Floyd County Election Board makes the following findings of fact:

(1) the Floyd County Election Board anticipates 20 absentee ballot applications to vote in the office of the circuit court clerk in the special election;


(2) the expense that would be incurred if absentee voting was offered in the office of the circuit court clerk during the entire period required under IC 3-11-10-26 would be \$2960.00; and

(3) the voters of the Town of Greenville would experience little or no inconvenience by restricting absentee ballot voting in the office to the days and hours specified in this resolution.


Resolution
