

Floyd County Election Board Resolution No. 2015-03  
Vote Center Plan Amendment

Whereas, the Floyd County Vote Center Plan was duly adopted on October 10, 2012; and,

Whereas, Indiana Code 3-11-18.1-15 authorizes Floyd County to amend a plan adopted with a county election board's order under I.C. 3-11-18.1-3 by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the board approving the plan amendment; and

Whereas, the Floyd County Election Board so approves the Floyd County plan amendment for vote centers in Floyd County, Indiana.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE FLOYD COUNTY ELECTION BOARD;

The vote center locations shall be as follows:


The Election Board of Floyd County adopts this Order to approve the Floyd County Vote Center Plan Amendments.

## FLOYD COUNTY ELECTION BOARD

Witnesseth: that the Floyd County Election Board adopted electronic voting for the County and submitted its plan to the State Election Board after public hearing all as required by law;

Further that the Board has adopted a plan for the counting of all votes cast in early voting that produced a ballot that was then put into an envelope with signature of the voter and initials of the Clerks that was then counted on election day;

Further that those envelopes were then opened by the Board on Election day and scanned by the Board;

That the procedure is cumbersome, and requires many man hours, and does not improve the integrity of the voter nor improve the election process in anyway;

Therefore the Floyd County Election Board RESOLVES as follows:

That henceforth, All Early voting on the OVI machines will be scanned upon the voter completing the process of voting into the Tabulator;

Further: That at the end of each day the counted ballots and the thumb drives will be stored at the County Clerks Election Office under lock and key with two (2) locks, one from each of the two Election Board Representatives. That said Thumb Drives not be opened and recapped until Election Day when counting of all votes in said election commences.

That a copy of this Resolution as adopted by this Board be certified to the Indiana Election Board for keeping in its records.

Witnesseth: that the Floyd County Election Board adopted electronic voting for the County and submitted its plan to the State Election Board after public hearing all as required by law;

Further the Floyd County Election Board was advised as to the voting procedure in the use of said method of voting;

Further the Floyd County Board was advised after the purchase of said machines that the State Election Board had given its opinion that the paper produced by the OVI machine was a "Ballot" that required the signatures of the two (2) clerks at the voting place prior to its being read by the Tabulator;


Further the Floyd County Board has observed that the procedure requires the two Clerks at each site to issue a number for each voter to use the OVI equipment, and that to require another step in the processed only impedes the voting process and is redundant;


Therefore the Floyd County Election Board hereby resolves as follows:

That in future elections all "ballots" produced by the OVI machine, will no longer, in order to be considered a legal ballot, need to have the initials of two (2) clerks upon said "ballot".

Further that this resolution with the signatures of the entire Floyd County Election Board be certified by the Clerk to the Indiana Election Board as a finding by this Board.
