**RANDOLPH COUNTY ELECTION BOARD**

**ORDER ADOPTING VOTE CENTER PLAN AMENDMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Randolph County Vote Center Plan was adopted on September 21, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, Indiana Code 3-11-18.1-15 authorizes Randolph County to amend a plan adopted with a county election board's order under IC 3-11-18.1-3 by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the board approving the plan amendment.

**WHEREAS**, the Randolph County Election believes this amendment will provide a way to view election specific data. We find this approach will eliminate the need to update the "Plan" for each Election.

**WHEREAS**, the Randolph County Election Board so approves the Randolph County Vote Center Plan amendment for Vote Centers in Randolph County.

**WHEREAS**, the Randolph County Election Board has determined that during Municipal Elections, the vote centers that correlate with the towns having an Election, will be the vote centers that open on Election Day.

**BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE RANDOLPH COUNTY ELECTION BOARD:**

1. For all Randolph County Presidential and Mid-Term Elections the Vote Center locations will be as follows:

Randolph County Courthouse, Lobby, 100 S Main St, Winchester, IN  
4-H Fairground, Husted Hall, 1885 S US 27, Winchester, IN  
Trinity Lutheran Church, 1470 W St Rd 28, Union City, IN  
Hoosier Place Apartments, 310 N Walnut St, Union City, IN  
Calvary United Methodist Church, 200 S Portland St, Ridgeville, IN  
Parker City Volunteer Fire Department, 231 E Howard St, Parker City, IN  
Farmland City Building, 104 E Henry St, Farmland, IN  
Word of Hope Church, 8418 W Hwy 36, Modoc, IN  
Lynn City Building, 103 S Main St, Lynn, IN

2. Trinity Lutheran Church and Parker City Volunteer Fire Department will be the satellite locations for the two Saturday's prior to the Election.

3. For Randolph County Municipal Elections the Vote Centers will be as follows:

Randolph County Courthouse, Lobby, 100 S Main St, Winchester, IN  
4-H Fairground, Husted Hall, 1885 S US 27, Winchester, IN  
Trinity Lutheran Church, 1470 W St Rd 28, Union City, IN  
Hoosier Place Apartments, 310 N Walnut St, Union City, IN

4. Trinity Lutheran Church and Husted Hall will be the satellite locations for the two Saturday's prior to the Election.

5. The Randolph County Vote Center Plan is hereby amended so that in the event that a small town in Randolph County would have a Municipal General Election, the following Vote Center(s) would open for the respective town(s):

Ridgeville: Calvary United Methodist Church, 200 S Portland St, Ridgeville, IN

Parker City: Parker City Volunteer Fire Department, 231 E Howard St, Parker City, IN

Farmland: Farmland City Building, 104 E Henry St, Farmland, IN

Modoc: Word of Hope Church, 8418 W Hwy 36, Modoc, IN

Losantville: Word of Hope Church, 8418 W Hwy 36, Modoc, IN

Lynn: Lynn City Building, 103 S Main St, Lynn, IN

A copy of this resolution amending the Randolph County Vote Center Plan shall be filed with the Indiana Election Division.


The Election Board of Randolph County hereby approves and adopts the Vote Center Plan Amendment.


Further, this resolution shall take effect immediately and may only be rescinded by the unanimous vote of the entire membership of the Randolph County Election Board.
