## ADDMENDMENT #3

### Municipal Vote Center and Early Vote Center Locations

Vigo County plans to utilize 12 Vote Center Locations: Indiana Code 3-11-18.1-6 only requires one vote center per 10,000 active voters, but Vigo County Election Board plans to provide, for the municipal election, one vote center per 3395 active voters.

- (A) Total number of registered voters within the Municipality is – 40738
- (B) Total number of active voters within the Municipality - 33234
- (C) Total number of inactive voters within the Municipality - 7504

The Courthouse will be open 28 days prior to Election Day from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and open two (2) Saturdays prior to Election Day from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

The Following are vote center location to be open two weeks prior to Election Day from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Tuesday thru Saturday and closed Sunday and Mondays.

1. Vigo County Annex

The following are vote center location to be open one week prior to Election Day from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Tuesday thru Saturday and Closed Sunday and Monday.

1. Baesler's Grocery Store

The following are vote center locations to be open **Election Day**:

1. Vigo County Annex – 127 Oak Street, Terre Haute IN
2. Baesler's Grocery Store – 2900 Poplar Street, Terre Haute IN
3. Plaza North Shopping Center Old Movie Theater - 1480 Ft. Harrison Rd., Terre Haute IN
4. VFW – 1111 Veteran Sq., Terre Haute IN
5. Booker T. Washington Center – 1101 S. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Terre Haute IN
6. Christway Church – 2901 S. 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Terre Haute IN
7. Memorial United Methodist Church – 2701 Poplar Street, Terre Haute IN
8. National Guard Armory – 3614 Maple Avenue, Terre Haute IN
9. Crosslane Community Church – 2204 Lafayette, Terre Haute IN
10. Vigo County Public Library – One Library Square, Terre Haute IN
11. Union Christian Church – 5350 E. Hulman Drive, Terre Haute IN
12. American Legion – 2690 Ft. Harrison Rd., Terre Haute IN

The Municipal plan shall be utilized in conjunction with the plan that was previously submitted.

The Board, by a unanimous vote of the entire membership of the Board, approved the Third Amendment on March 6, 2015.

This Amendment shall become effective upon its filing with the Indiana Election Division.

Whereas, the IC 3-11-18.1-15 allows the local Election Board to amend the county's vote center plan; and,

Whereas, the Vigo County Election Board has determined it is in the interest of the citizens of Vigo County to properly update the plan as needed; and,


Whereas, the timeframe for adopting this resolution is not prescribed in statute; but rather becomes effective upon the unanimous vote of the entire membership;


