VIGO COUNTY ELECTION BOARD RESOLUTION

The Vigo County Election Board adopted electronic voting for the County and submitted its plan to the State Election Board after public hearing all as require by law;

Further that the Board was advised as to the voting procedure in the use of said method of voting;

Further the Vigo County Election Board was advised after the purchase of said machines that the State Election Board had given its opinion that the paper produced by the OVI machine was a "Ballot" that required the signatures of the two (2) clerks at the voting place prior to its being read by the Tabulator;

Further the Vigo County Election Board has observed that the procedure requires the two Clerks at each site to issue a number for each voter to use the OVI equipment, and that to require another step in the processed only impedes the voting process and is redundant;

Therefore the Vigo County Election Board hereby resolves as follows;

That in future elections all "ballots" produced by the OVI machine, will no longer, in order to be considered a legal ballot, need to have the initials of two (2) clerks upon said "ballot".

Further that this resolution with the signatures of the entire Vigo County Election Board be certified by the Clerk to the Indiana Election Board as a finding by this Board.

VIGO COUNTY ELECTION BOARD RESOLUTION

The Vigo County Election Board adopted electronic voting for the County and submitted its plan to the State Election after public hearing all as required by law.

Further that the Board has adopted a plan for the counting of all votes cast in early voting that produce a ballot that was then put into an envelope with signature of the voter and initials of the clerks that was then counted on election day;

Further that those envelopes were then opened by the Board on Election Day and scanned by the Board;

That the procedure is cumbersome, and requires many man hours, and does not improve the integrity of the voter or improve the election process in anyway;

Therefore the Vigo County Election Board RESOLVES as follows:

That henceforth, All Early Voting on the OVI machines will be scanned upon the voter completing the process of voting into the Tabulator;

Further: That at the end of each day the cast ballots will be stored at the County Clerks Election Office under lock and key with two (2) locks, one from each of the two Election Board Representatives. That said thumb drives will be kept and sealed at each Early Vote Center. When the Early Vote Center closes, the thumb drive will be stored at the County Clerks Election Office under lock and key with two (2) locks, one from each of the Election Board Representatives. At 6:00 p.m. on Election night the thumb drives from each Early Vote Center will be tabulated.

That a copy of this Resolution as adopted by this Board be certified to the Indiana Election Board for keeping in its records.
