

WABASH COUNTY ELECTION BOARD
VOTE CENTER PLAN AMENDMENT #3

WHEREAS, the Wabash County Vote Center Plan was duly adopted on February 28, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 3-11-18.1-15 authorizes Wabash County to amend a plan adopted under 3-11-18.1-3 by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the board approving the plan amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Wabash County Election board has determined that the vote center plan previously adopted should be amended to reflect changes for the 2015 City and Town elections; and

WHEREAS, the Wabash County Election board has determined that it would be beneficial to put into place a second e-poll book (as needed) at certain vote center locations, with each of the Poll Clerks operating an e-poll book without the necessity of adding two (2) sets of Poll Clerks. This would be for all future elections; and

WHEREAS, the Wabash County Election Board so approves the Wabash County plan amendment for vote centers in Wabash County, Indiana.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE WABASH COUNTY ELECTION BOARD:

1. Wabash County will utilize four (4) vote center sites on Election Day, Nov 3, 2015:





RESOLUTION NO. 2015-2
ESTABLISHING DATE AND HOURS FOR IN-PERSON
ABSENTEE VOTING
FOR NOVEMBER 2015 GENERAL ELECTION

Recitals

Whereas, a certain number of voters will vote in the November 3, 2015 general election in Wabash County by absentee in the office of the Circuit Court Clerk before an absentee voter board pursuant to IC 3-11-10-25;

Whereas, the Wabash County Election Board desires to enact a resolution to set the absentee voting hours for absentee voting in the office of the circuit court clerk before an absentee voter board pursuant to IC 3-11-10-26.5

Findings of Fact

Now, therefore, in support of this resolution, the Wabash County Election board makes the following findings of fact:

1. The Wabash County Election Board anticipates 250 absentee ballot applications to vote in the office of the circuit court clerk in the November 2015 general election; and
2. The expense that would be incurred if absentee voting was offered in the office of the circuit court clerk during the entire period required under IC 3-11-10-26 would be \$2,700.00-\$2,800.00; and
3. The voters would experience little or no inconvenience by restricting absentee ballot voting in the office to the days and hours specified in this resolution.


BE IT THEREOFRE RESOLVED that, pursuant to IC 3-11-10-26.5, and the findings listed above, the Wabash County Election Board, by unanimous vote of the board's entire membership, sets the days and hours for **absentee voting**

for the November 2015 general election in the office of the circuit court clerk before an absentee voting board, as follows:

Saturday, Oct 24, 2015 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon
Mon-Fri Oct 26-Oct 30 from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm
Saturday, Oct 31 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon
Monday, Nov 2, 2015 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon
