

County officials consider voting options

Secretary of State Connie Lawson's meeting at the Carroll County Courthouse Monday brings possibility of voting centers to White County, said White County Clerk Paula Lantz.

"The purpose of hosting the meeting is to give county officials information on if they want to adopt this model," said Lawson.

She explained the benefits of having a voting center compared with traditional voting polls is the cost savings and the ability for voters to vote anywhere in their county. A voting center allows a person to vote at any convenient center located throughout a county and the ballot to be automatically updated to the Clerk's Office.
