Lawson To Discuss Vote Centers With County Election Officials

Indiana Secretary of State Connie Lawson will be meeting with Bartholomew County election officials this afternoon to determine if the vote center model, an alternative to traditional precinct elections, is something the county should consider.

Secretary Lawson will highlight how the vote center model can reduce the costs of elections for counties, while providing voters with the convenience of choosing where they vote.

The meeting will begin at 2 this afternoon in the Bartholomew County Council Chambers, located at 440 Third Street in Columbus.
