"As a cowboy at heart and a public servant by calling, there's no better place to connect with the people I serve than right here in Shipshewana," said Treasurer Elliott. "This rodeo celebrates tradition, teamwork, and perseverance—all values that guide my work every day as State Treasurer."

Elliott's presence at the rodeo reflects his continued commitment to rural engagement. During his visit, he will meet with community leaders to discuss ways the Treasurer's Office is supporting growth and opportunity across Indiana.
