Late Fees:

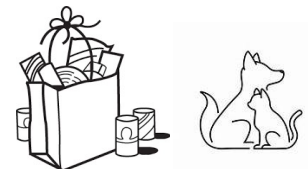
Recently there seems to be some confusion regarding when late fees are applied. Late fees are added to any outstanding accounts on the first business day after the 20th. Because we have multiple payment methods available, this is still applicable if we are closed on the 20th. All payments in the drop box, any payments in our PO Box, and any credit card payments that have been made online are processed prior to adding any late fees. Drive -thru Food Distribution is open to ALL Boone County residents. It is open the third Tuesday of each month from 4 to 5 PM at the Advance Volunteer Fire Department (106 E Wall) Please be sure to not block streets or intersections. Please follow instructions from the volunteers in order to keep everyone safe and things running smoothly.

Reach Alert:

We use the ReachAlert text system to notify residents of information they may need or want to know. A few of these things would include scheduled outages, road closures, boil orders, meeting and/or office hours changes, updates during unscheduled outages, and more.

If you are not signed up, have

changed phone numbers/emails, or have opted out of these messages, you may not get the information since this is our primary way to notify you when these things happen and we cannot control who does or does not have Facebook. ANY time you change your contact information, the office NEEDS to know.
