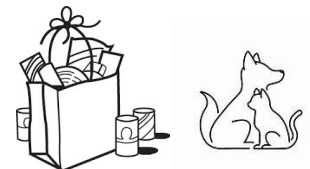
Don't forget when you change your clocks to also test your smoke detectors and check for an expiration date. Most are recommended to be replaced after 10 years.
