Hydrant Flushing:

The April hydrant flushing was postponed to May 12. While they are flushing the fire hydrant, water pressure will drop, but will return to normal pretty quickly after they close it back up.

Sprinkler Meters:

It is the time of year when people start filling their pools. This is a reminder that if you wish to receive a sewer credit, you must have a sprinkler meter on the hose you use to fill it. You can purchase a meter from the Town (cost is \$80) or get one on your own elsewhere.

If you do purchase one elsewhere, we would prefer they measure in gallons if at all possible

Pet Tags:

We started doing pet tags back in 2016 because we know that sometimes, despite our best efforts, pets do get out. There can be fees or fines associated with reclaiming your pet if they are turned over to animal control or the humane society

As part of the pet tag process at the Town Hall, we keep shot records on file and take a photo of your pet so we can help identify your fur-babies if they achieve their great escape.

We charge \$5 per tag up to 3 tags, any after the 3rd are free and they need to be renewed annually.
