# **Check Payments**:

When you are writing a check to pay your utility bill, please verify all of he information provided is correct. The amount written in numbers, and the amount written in words must match. If they do not match the bank will take the check for the amount written in words.

#### **Golf Cart Tags**:

2024 Golf Cart Stickers have arrived!!. The cost for these remain \$30/year.

#### Pet Tags:

Pet Tags are in!!! The cost remains the same. \$5/pet for up to three pets, no charge for any additional pets.



If you are walking your dog, it is your responsibility to pick up your dog's waste. It definitely isn't very neighborly to leave it in someone else's yard or sidewalks.

### Septic Tanks:

Please do not pour large amounts of grease or oil down your drains. When we dump the contents of your septic tanks, we will get charged around \$700 extra per tank due to the high grease/oil content. In situations such as this we will have little choice but to bill the resident for the extra cost.

## Recycling Bin:

We are still seeing bags and boxes stacked up against the recycling receptacle. If you notice someone doing this, please report it.

The recycling bin at the corner of S Main/E Wall is currently provided at no cost to the Town or its residents. Please make sure you are following the guidelines that are posted on the bin.

There is to be NO residential trash (food) placed in the bin. The only bagged item that should be placed in the bin is shredded paper.

Placing your household trash in or next to the bin is considered dumping and could very well cause the county solid waste division to remove the bin.

For information on where you can take items that should not be placed in the recycle bin, visit boonecountysolidwaste.com They have a list of places you can take things like televisions, tires, chemical waste, and other hard to dispose of items year round.

It needs to not be obscured by vegetation and such, and the color of the numbers should contrast with the background. If at all possible, it should be reflective. This will help emergency services find you quicker in the event you need their help. As you probably know, in our area GPS is not always 100% accurate.
