

**ANDREWS TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES
OF A PUBLIC MEETING HELD APRIL 13, 2026**

A public meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Andrews, Indiana convened on April 13, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. at the Andrews Town Hall in accordance with applicable law and pursuant to appropriate notice.

ROLL CALL

Council Members Laura Dillon and Roger Newsome, Jr. were in attendance. Michael Dean Young was not present due to a work conflict. Deputy-Clerk Treasurer Sarah Geiger-Okuly declared a quorum was present and the meeting would continue.

APPROVAL OF COUNCIL MINUTES

Roger Newsome made a motion to approve council minutes for a Regular Session held on March 23, 2026. Laura Dillon seconded the motion, which was approved 2-0.

OLD BUSINESS

2026 CCMG: The Town's local match to the project from the state was deposited into the Town's bank account last week.

Colin Bullock reported that paving will begin this summer after school gets out.

It was also noted that the bike kiosk is waiting for the installation of the pump, rack, and tool kit. A request was made for a second bench to be placed in the area after the other items are addressed.

NEW BUSINESS

Resolution 2026-03 Authorizing the transfer of MVH Restricted funds to LRS Bridge MGF was approved. Roger Newsome made a motion to approve the resolution. Laura Dillon seconded the motion, resolution approved 2-0.

Colin has filed a permit for the Jefferson and Main Street project. He stated he is waiting for a list of items before he can move forward with a cost list.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Police Department: Town Marshal Josh Platt reported that he has identified approximately 20 town violations this week. Abandoned car, garbage and weed violations identified. He also explained to the counsel what constitutes an abandoned vehicle.

This upcoming week there will be defensive tactics training.

Last week Reserve Officer Dan completed his 16-hour patrol rifle training.

The new car has been decaled. It should arrive in 2 weeks complete.

Fire Department: No report was given.

Utility Department: Colin Bullock stated the well digging went well; we are now waiting for results of the water to determine if there are any unwanted chemicals. The test wells were dug 153 feet deep. The 2 new wells will be 12 inches in diameter and 153 feet deep. We can move forward when the paperwork is received.

Deputy-Clerk-Treasurer: Sarah Geiger-Okuly reported that the Town's local match transfer to the CCMG project has been approved this evening. That the Town Hall will host an early voting center on Friday April 24, 2026, from 8:00AM-3:00PM. The ARPA annual report was filed April 8, 2026. All obligated funds were expended. The TRECS disbursement was received in the amount of \$558.64 and notification that there will be 2 more payments in early May.

CLAIMS

Roger Newsome made a motion to approve the claims as presented, which was seconded by Laura Dillon. The motion was approved 2-0.

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OTHER BUSINESS & PUBLIC COMMENT

Mirriah Bigelow reported to the Council a change in the plans for the second annual fireworks festival on July 3, from 6pm to 10pm. Due to a conflict of county events, she does not have permission to close State Road 105 and will reconfigure the design layout for the band, pro wrestling, food trucks, bouncy houses and vendor booths.


With no further business, Dillon motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:16p.m., seconded by Newsome.
