

**ANDREWS TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES
OF A PUBLIC MEETING HELD MAY 26, 2026**

A public meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Andrews, Indiana convened on May 26, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. at the Andrews Town Hall in accordance with applicable law and pursuant to appropriate notice.

ROLL CALL

Council Members Laura Dillon, Roger Newsome, Jr., and Michael Dean Young were in attendance. Clerk-Treasurer Laury Powell declared a quorum was present and the meeting would continue.

APPROVAL OF COUNCIL MINUTES

Roger Newsome made a motion to approve council minutes for a Regular Session held on May 11, 2026, and for a Special Meeting held May 21, 2026. Dean Young seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved 3-0.

OLD BUSINESS

Colin Bullock said the CCMG paving project could begin as early as Thursday or next week. He also reported that the county's resurfacing on River Road is complete, but the North Main Street bridge closed this week for INDOT work.

Laura Dillon said engineering firms have been engaged to explore a potential south well field and that there were no new developments to report. She then asked for comments or questions from attendees, but none were stated.

NEW BUSINESS

Powell announced there will be a school lunch program at the town park this year and that a flyer has been shared with the public.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Police Department: Town Marshal Josh Platt reported that abatements are in progress and that he will cite additional properties this week for tall grass, weeds, junk, and debris.

Fire Department: Young said Bippus and Huntington Township volunteer firefighters will help cover Dallas Township during the SR105 bridge work and closure.

Utility Department: Colin Bullock had nothing additional to report than previously discussed.

Clerk-Treasurer: Laury Powell reported on recent office activities along with a MUST meeting held in Huntington in response to HEA 1210, which allows Indiana counties to establish a municipal unit strategic task force (MUST) to collaboratively negotiate Local Income Tax (LIT) distribution and rates.

CLAIMS

Dean Young made a motion to approve the claims as presented, which was seconded by Roger Newsome. The motion was approved 3-0.

OTHER BUSINESS & PUBLIC COMMENT

Neal Snyder, 55 N Main St, said he purchased a 25-gallon water tank and has access to a small trailer to water the downtown flowers. He is seeking additional volunteers to help.

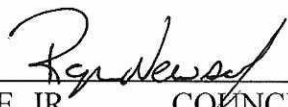
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| With no further business, Newsome motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:11 p.m., seconded by Young.
