Residential Development

Daniel Hartman addressed the Council, on behalf of CC Murphy, LLC, concerning a proposed development on the property at 501 N Armstrong. Consensus was that the lot sizes proposed were too small to meet Town Ordinances, or any precedence set of allowing variance to size. Mr. Hartman will report Council requests for lot sizes to Mr. Murphy. No further action was taken.

Utility and Municipal Updates

Josh McNulty, GoCo, advised Council that SRF applications, pertaining to the ongoing water project, have been completed, signed, and sent. He then discussed phosphorus removal processes, and need for upgrades for the process, at the wastewater plant. He advised that SRF funding left from the sewer project is available to fund the needed changes. He also gave updates on the CCMG project on S Preston Street, Pre Construction meeting was to be held on Wednesday, 4/8/2026.

Approval of Resolution 2026-5, A Resolution of the Town of Crothersville, In, Establishing a Policy for Rounding Cash Payments on Municipal Utility Accounts Due to the Limited Availability of one-cent coins. Danieta Foster, Clerk Treasurer advised that this has not yet

become a problem for the Town, but in anticipation the State of Indiana has requested all municipalities adopt these standards. Motion: Jamy Greathouse 2nd: Chad Wilson Carries: 5-0

Due to the resignation of Zach Elliott, and his move to the Jackson County Sheriff's Dept, the Sheriff, and the County Council, has asked to have K-9 Bora transferred with Officer Elliott. They have also asked to purchase the 2023 Dodge Durango, which was equipped for K-9 use by a grant from the State of Indiana, this purchase has been approved by the Jackson County Council in the amount of \$29,727.23. Approved. Motion: Jamy Greathouse 2nd: Jason Hillenburg Carries 5-0.

Discussion of the other 2023 Dodge Durango on the same Bond Bank loan was discussed. Council approved using \$29,727.23 from CREDIT to pay off the full loan. Motion: Jamy Greathouse 2nd: Jason Hillenburg Carries 5-0.

Acting Chief Jonathon Tabor discussed trading the 2024 Dodge Durango, which was outfitted for K-9 use, in the future. There has been an offer from Bachman Auto of \$30,000 in trade in for the vehicle. No action taken at this time.

Discussion was held about K-9 Lunya. Official retirement, due to health concerns was approved. Motion: Jamy Greathouse 2nd: Mark Wilkerson Carries: 5-0.

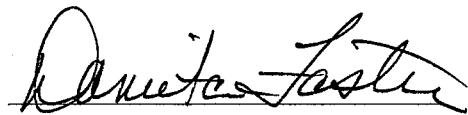
