

Regular July Meeting Minutes July 7, 2026

Regular Business

Utility and Municipal Updates

Josh McNaulty, GoCo, discussed present CCMG project on Preston Street. Preston Street will be closed to thru traffic beginning July 8, 2026, a water line will be moved this week (week of July 6th), this will involve a full town shut down of water. A water main problem at Preston and Moore will be repaired at the same time. The culvert for Hominy Ditch will arrive next week (week of July 13th). A 3-week construction time is predicted.

It was also discussed that discussions are happening concerning projects for the next phase of CCMG.

Council Approved Pay App 12, in the amount of \$19,231.08, from READI Funds, for Maguire Iron, for payment on the water tower. Motion: Jamy Greathouse. 2nd: Mark Wilkerson. Carries: 4-0.

Ordinance 2026-5, An Ordinance establishing an annual sewer invoice adjustment for pool filling" was approved on 1st Reading. Motion: Jamy Greathouse. 2nd: Mark Wilkerson. Carries: 4-0.

Approved suspending the rules to hold second reading of Ordinance 2026-5. Motion: Jamy Greathouse. 2nd: Chad Wilson. Carries 4-0.

Approved Ordinance 2026-5 on 2nd Reading. Motion: Jamy Greathouse. 2nd: Mark Wilkerson. Carries 4-0.

This ordinance will allow for a ONE time per year adjustment to sewer only for pool fills. Pool owners must call to ask for an adjustment prior to filling pool.

Misc

Jason Bukowski, Shepherd Moore Ins, was present to present renewal proposals for the Town's blanket coverage from Astra Ins. The 2025/2026 plan cost the Town \$65,204.00. There will be an increase of \$1736 for the 2026/2027 coverage, bringing the plan costs to \$66,940.00. The deductible for property damage/loss will be \$10,000.00.

Council approved the proposal to continue coverage for the Town with Astra Insurance. Motion: Jamy Greathouse. 2nd: Mark Wilkerson. Carries:4-0.

Willis Collier, new owner of 6459 S US Hwy 31, came before the Council to ask permission to live in a 5th wheel camper, temporarily, during construction of a permanent structure. Due to the nature of his work, he will not be on the property at all times, and is not sure of a timeline of construction.

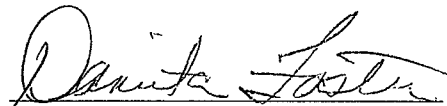
Council approved a variance to Town Ordinances disallowing living in a recreational vehicle, allowing Mr Collier to use the 5th wheel as temporary residence for up to 1 year. If at that time the permanent structure is not complete the matter will be revisited. Motion: Jamy Greathouse. 2nd: Mark Wilkerson. Carries: 4-0.

Jerry Bridge, Bridge Construction, was present to discuss progress on the subdivision on 1025 E. He advised that they plan to break ground this week (week of June 6th), will have finished plans to present by the end of the week. No action taken.

ORDINANCE NO. 2026 - 5

"An Ordinance establishing an annual sewer invoice adjustment for pool filling."

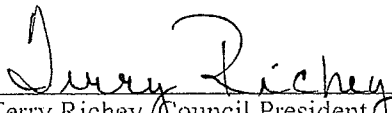
WHEREAS, there now exists a need in the Town of Crothersville, Indiana (the "Town"), to establish an annual adjustment to customers' sewer invoices for filling swimming pools; and

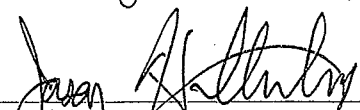
WHEREAS, the Town Council of Crothersville, Indiana, hereby codifies said adjustment.

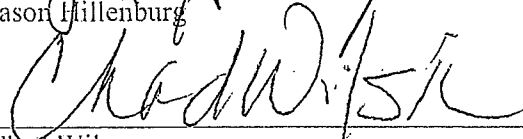
NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CROTHERSVILLE, INDIANA:

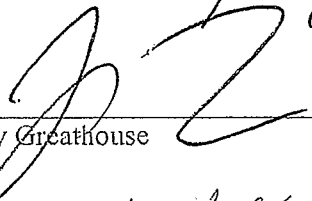
- Section 1:** Town sewer customers who have a swimming pool may receive one sewer invoice adjustment per year to account for filling the swimming pool. The invoice will be adjusted to the average of the previous three (3) sewer invoices for each customer. This adjustment must be requested from the sewer billing department between the months of May and August in order to be applied.
- Section 2:** If any section, paragraph, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of said ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.
- Section 3:** All prior ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 4:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and approval by the Town Council, all as by law provided.

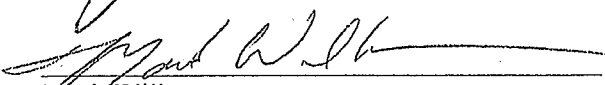

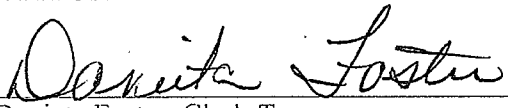
