ORDINANCE 2018-001

An Ordinance of the Town of Culver Amending and Restating Traffic, Parking and Pedestrian Regulations within the Town of Culver, Indiana.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Culver, Indiana has control over the streets, alleys, crosswalks, and parking requirements of said Town; and

WHEREAS, because of concerns for safety which have been raised, it is believed to be necessary to establish signage on certain streets of said Town to assist in the proper flow of pedestrian and vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Town has the authority to implement parking restrictions within Town limits; NOW

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Culver Town Council as follows:

1. Designating a Congested Motor Vehicle Traffic and Pedestrian area on Lakeshore Drive

The town designates Lakeshore Drive from approximately 508 Lakeshore Drive east to 824 Lakeshore Drive as a "Congested Area," with signage to bring attention to the presence of a higher volume of pedestrians in the area.

2. Creating a No Parking Zone on Both Sides of the Street at the Corner of Batabano and South Plymouth Street

No parking allowed on either side of the street for 50 feet from the intersection of Batabano Street and South Plymouth Street to the east on Batabano Street and to the south on Plymouth Street.

- 3. Amending and Updating Parking Restrictions on Ohio Street
 - a. No Parking allowed on the east side of Ohio Street from Davis to Mill Street.
 - b. No parking allowed on either side of Ohio Street from Washington Street to Jefferson Street.
- 4. Banning on Street Parking of Semi-Trucks and Trailers in Residential Zones

a. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a semitractor or other truck exceeding 5 tons on a public street in any residential zone, as designated by the zoning ordinance and town map. This prohibition shall not apply to the parking or standing of such a vehicle for the purpose of making pick-ups or deliveries from or to any building or structure located within such residential zone, or for the purpose of delivering materials to be used in the repair, alteration, remodeling or construction of any such building or structure for which a building permit has been obtained. The prohibition shall not apply to any semitractor or truck exceeding 5 tons parked upon private property.

	b. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any semitractor or other truck exceeding 5 tons to permit said vehicle to idle in a residential area for a period greater than 15 minutes.
