

ORDINANCE 2021-014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CULVER AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS AT A SPECIFIED LOCATION WITHIN THE TOWN OF CULVER, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Town of Culver, Indiana, has control over the streets and alleys of said Town and have established certain traffic regulations to install signs and other traffic control signals at different locations around the Town; and

WHEREAS, due to safety concerns, it is necessary to establish signs on certain streets of said Town to assist in the proper flow of traffic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Culver Town Council as follows:

1. Effective upon the passage of this ordinance, a stop sign shall be placed on Cavalier Drive at the intersection of Sandhill Boulevard in order to control the flow of traffic on those two new streets;
2. Any person failing to stop on Cavalier Drive in violation of this ordinance is subject to the standard fines for said violation as has been previously adopted by the Town of Culver.
