

## ORDINANCE 2021-015

### AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CULVER TO ESTABLISH A ONE-WAY STREET AND OTHER TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS ON PORTIONS OF WASHINGTON STREET

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Culver, Indiana, has control over the streets and alleys of said Town and have established certain traffic regulations to install signs and other traffic control signals at different locations around the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has previously established Coolidge Court as a one-way street going south from Lakeshore Drive. The Town wishes to establish Washington Street between Coolidge Court and Lake Street as a one-way street going west.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Culver Town Council as follows:

1. A new article shall be added to the Culver Code of Ordinances providing that Washington Street shall be a one-way street going west from Coolidge Court to Lake Street.
2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its approval and adoption.

**PASSED and ADOPTED** by the Culver Town Council, Culver, Marshall County, Indiana, on the 14th day of December, 2021.
