AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION
AND LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT

**A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Culver, Indiana,
Authorizing the Submittal of the Park Improvement Application to the
Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs
and Addressing Related Matters**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Culver, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and

- a. **WHEREAS**, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low- and moderate-income persons; and
- b. **WHEREAS**, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government for the elimination and prevention of blight; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Culver, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low-and moderate-income residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Culver, Indiana as follows:

- 1. The Town Council President is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to complete necessary improvements and upgrades within the Union Township and Cavalier Park(s), and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 2. The Town of Culver, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of Three Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$340,000), in the form of a cash on hand within the Town's Rainy Day, Cumulative Capital Development, and General Funds, as matching funds for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of CDBG funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.






