

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Edgewood Town Council

The Meeting of the Edgewood Town Council was held on April 20, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. at 3405 Nichol Avenue, Town of Edgewood. The following persons were present:

Mr. Leak called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

Roll call was initiated after the pledge of allegiance. All council members were present.

**Report on the Edgewood Golf, Dining, and Event Center**

Ms. Michelle Skeen presented various financial reports. Discussion followed.

**Fire Department Report**

Captain Jordan White reported on the various EMS runs, transports, and fire activity for the month of March 2026. On October 3<sup>rd</sup> there will be a Fish & Chicken Fry, and August 8<sup>th</sup> there will be a 50/50 at the Anderson Speedway. There were various hours of training completed by the fire people. Discussion followed.

**Police Department Report**

Captain Aukerman reported on the various police activities for the month of March 2026. On April 26<sup>th</sup> there will be a Drug Take Back from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. Town Clean-up days will be possibly Maay 16<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. National Night Out will be August 4<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. Discussion followed.

**Water Department Report**

Mr. Ferguson updated the council and guests about on various activities his department were working on. Mowing and Meter Profiling were the most time consuming. Discussion followed.

**Member Reports**

Mr. Reed's report was presented by Captain Aukerman. Mr. Reed informed the council and guests that he would not be present at the May Regular Council Meeting.

Ms. Farran did not have a report.

Mr. Leak's report was presented by Captain Jordan White.

Mr. Pickett gave an update on the various park equipment that needed repair and/or removed. Discussion followed.

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Mr. McCord did not have a report.

Mr. Farran reported that two residents had contacted him regarding driveway extensions. He informed them of the ordinance and that they needed to be constructed of the same material as the current driveway. Mr. Farran stated that demolition on the property on Layton Road would begin May 1, 2026. Discussion followed.

### **Town Attorney Report**

Mr. Austin reported that he felt the estimate to demolish the house on Layton Road was a good price. Mr. Leak asked Mr. Austin to inquire about annexing the property the house sat on at Layton Road from Anderson into the Town of Edgewood. Discussion followed.

### **Town Engineer's Report**

Mr. Servies reminded the council of the following street paving bids: E & B Paving, LLC in the amount of \$313,846.50 and DC Construction Services, Inc. in the amount of \$321,955.36. Discussion followed. Mr. Reed made a motion to approve the bid from E & B Paving, LLC. In the amount of \$313,846.50 contingent on the town receiving a grant from the Community Crossings Grant. Ms. Farran seconded the motion. All members voting aye, motion carried.

### **Clerk-Treasurer's Report**

Ms. Tanner informed the council and guests that Shawna Atkins will be replacing Cristy Pitts as Accounting Clerk and Sherry Johnson will be replacing Wendy Wash as Deputy Clerk-Treasurer. She also informed the council and guests that there was no payment to the City of Anderson for Sewage Processing due to not receiving a bill yet. Discussion followed.

### **Old Business**

Mr. Pickett stated that he would like to address the Tree Ordinance and the Court Ordinance for updates.

Ms. Farran updated and reminded the council and guests of the various discussions the Long-Range Planning Committee had discussed. Items such as a new water tower, water line lead testing, paving, and other items. Discussion followed.

Ms. Farran asked Mrs. Brooke Parker-Diem to update the council on the various Fund-Raising Activities the Pool Committee were working on. There will be a Golf Outing on June 26, 2026 for raising funds for the pool. Discussion followed.

Mr. Pickett informed the council and guests he had two quotes for Dog Waste Stations. The town would be purchasing six (6) stations. Pet Waste Elimination quote was for \$1,976 and one for \$2,327. Discussion followed. Ms. Farran made a motion to approve the purchase of six (6) Pet Waste Stations for \$1,976.00. Mr. Farran seconded the motion. All members voting aye, motion carried.

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**New Business**

Mr. Leak presented and read Resolution Number 04-20-2026, “A Resolution Designating Bank Representatives.” Discussion followed. Ms. Farran made a motion to approve Resolution Number 04-20-2026. Mr. Pickett seconded the motion. All members voting aye, motion carried.

Mr. Leak asked about the progress of removing the Untreated Wood Chips from 215 Tower Road. Discussion followed.

**Comments & Questions**

David Lazelle, 2007 S. Edgewood Drive stated that there was a tree issue with his neighbor’s tree causing a potential hazard outcome. Discussion followed. Mrs. Brooke Parker-Diem asked about mains and service lines. Discussion followed.

Mr. Reed made a motion to approve the Minutes from the March 2026 Town Council Meeting. Mr. Farran seconded the motion. All members voting aye, motion carried.

**Approval of the Register of Claims**
