

ORDINANCE NUMBER 06-16-25

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARKING REGULATIONS  
FOR THE TOWN OF EDGEWOOD**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Edgewood, Indiana has adopted certain regulations about the parking of vehicles in the town; and

**WHEREAS**, as presently drafted, the Code of Ordinances, Section 71.21(C), states that one can park a "regulated vehicle" in a side yard or back yard, but the vehicle would have to be parked on a surface such as pavement, concrete, or gravel; and

**WHEREAS**, it would be appropriate and desirable to delete the reference to gravel in the foregoing Section 71.21 (C) for aesthetic reasons.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF EDGEWOOD, INDIANA, THAT SECTION 71.21(C) SHALL BE AMENDED TO DELETE THE REFERENCE TO GRAVEL. AS AMENDED, SECTION 71.21(C) SHALL PROVIDE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. In the event there is a need to park in a side yard or back yard, the regulated vehicle shall be parked on a hard surface such as pavement or concrete.
