OLD BUSINESS

MEETING MINUTES-The council reviewed minutes from last months meeting and signed off as being correct.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLES (JUNE)-The Clerk/Treasurer presented the payables for June for approval. The council reviewed. Jerry motioned the bills be allowed and paid, Woodrow second the motion, all in favor said Aye.

EMPLOYEE INSURANCE-The town has been looking for an insurance plan for the full time town employees. The Clerk/Treasurer duly noted that there was nothing allocated in the 2025 budget for this. The cost is being estimated at \$500/mo across the board and would have to come from the EDIT Account. Woodrow brought up questions as to whether the rates are locked in and there are other questions he believes needs to be researched before this is approved. Since this will be town funded for the employees (4) he thinks we should ask the insurance representative to come to the next public session so the public can ask questions and everyone get the answers needed. This will be set up

hopefully for the next board meeting, Woodrow motioned the subject of the employee insurance be tabled for now, Jerry 2nd motion, all in favor said Aye.

NEW BUSINESS – Reading of 2025-2-A1 AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SEWER REGULATIONS

Courtney read the Amendment and asked the council vote. Woodrow would not accept the amendment as it was only the first reading and any amendments, ordinances, resolutions etc., have to be read at 2 meetings before being voted on. The Clerk/Treasurer will add this to next month's agenda to review the amendment again and either pass or deny.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – There were questions brought up regarding the **trees being trimmed, easements** and the fact that the property owner pays for the entire piece of property but then has to give up property already paid for to accommodate for utility easements.

The subject was brought up again regarding the corner of 2nd and Cyrus. The attorney is going to have to send Joink a letter and tell them to fix it correctly or the whole corner will just crumble away. It was caused by Joink when running their fiber optics.

There is a hole at 3rd and Heap Street that was not repaired by INAW when there was a water main problem so they need to be contacted. It was asked if they had obtained a permit.


