**New Business-**

**CONCRETE FOR TOWN HALL PARKING LOT & SURROUNDING BUILDING**

This is to help with the flooding of the town hall and to make the building ADA compliant. We have 3 bids:

G & S Asphalt-\$11,525

E&B Paving-\$27,675 & \$11,275 (small bid is for 2 sections of parking in front of the building to make ADA compliant)

Travis Pinkston-\$12,500

A vote will be taken at the next meeting to award the bid to one of the contractors.

**MAIN STREET STUMP EXCAVATING**-There has been a bid awarded to Stump and Grind to remove the uprooted tree stump from the previous storm we had. **TOWN HALL ROOF**

A leak has appeared in the town hall building at the back of the board room. There were 5 companies contacted to give estimates. The Town Council President has suggested we turn this as a claim into the insurance due to the recent hail damage we received.

**Old Business**

**STATUS OF THE VAC TRUCK**-The truck is all together but more hydraulic fluid is needed in order to make sure it is working correctly. A request was given to purchase a 35-gallon drum of hydraulic fluid to complete this job and have additional fluid on hand that will work in all of the other pieces of equipment we have. Going forward it has been suggested that mechanical work be taken to an outside business to complete as it has taken too long to get the truck up and running by our mechanics. Jerry gave 1<sup>st</sup> motion for approval of purchase and 3<sup>rd</sup> party to repair, Courtney 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion, all in favor said Aye.

**SEWER PUMP**-the pump is not working correctly and the Sewer Operations Laborer will obtain a quote for Re-buid vs New.

**DUMP TRUCK**-Status on the dump truck was asked. The radiator now needs fixed due to Coming loose and going into the radiator as well as rear brakes are needed. The radiator will be outsourced and brakes are to be fixed next.

**LAWN MOWER**-the mower used to mow the vacant lots and properties throughout the town has blades that are getting dull. The Operations Manager has asked for new blades, another person has asked why they cannot just be sharpened. No decision made yet.

**MEETING MINUTES**-The board reviewed minutes from the previous meeting. Woodrow motioned for approval, Jennifer second the motion and all said Aye.

**PAYABLES**-Payables were reviewed for the month that were paid or needed paid. Jerry motioned for approval of payment, Woodrow 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion, Courtney abstained, and all said Aye.
