**Old business**

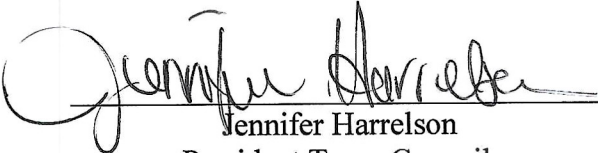

**New Business**

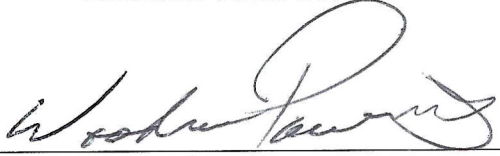
- **Inspection Summary/Noncompliance letter**

- **The annual Easter Egg Hunt** will be April 19, 2025 at 11:00 A.M.

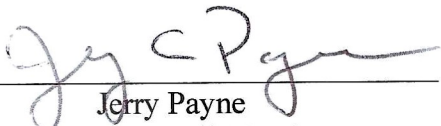
- Permission was asked from a Park Board member if they could announce on the Community Facebook Page there will be openings for 2 Republicans to be placed on the Park Board.

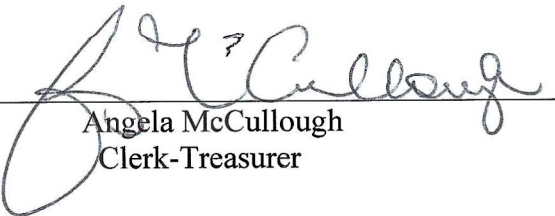

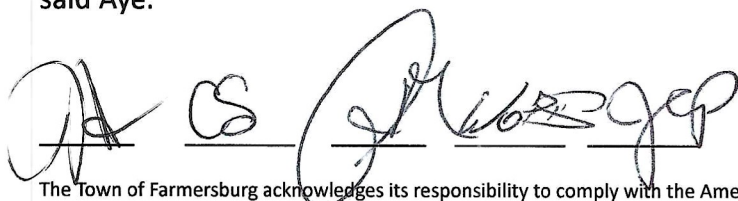
**HWC-MAIN STREET PROJECT PHASE 1**
