Vice President Suellyn Mickem opened the meeting at precisely 7:00 pm.

Member Naylor motioned to approve the agenda with flexibility, Member Bowser seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Council Member Bowser made a motion to approve minutes from the July 3, 2017, motion was seconded by Member Naylor. Motion carried.

WASTEWATER:

- Received & discharged 10.868 mg of treated wastewater
- Effluent flow averaged 20% of the design capacity
- Reports submitted to IDEM
- Asked to sell an old trash pump in the county surplus auction. Member Bowser motioned to allow the sale, Member Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Water:

- Plumbed new curb stop on High Street
- Drilled new service on 50N
- Advised Anu Sahni about his old service on High Street
- 4-H adding 10 temporary RV hookups
- Directed Woodland Hills resident ot contact County Surveyor about culverts
- "The Farm" is in the process of costing out utility attachment.

- Reported that the State Board of Accounts audit will be complete at the end of the week.
- Recommended an open meeting to discuss budget needs for Thursday, July 27th following the scheduled executive session. Meeting was set.
