LaGrange Town Council Meeting

Monday, April 6, 2026

The meeting began at 6:00 pm with Member Bowser motioning to approve the agenda, Member Shotzman seconded. Motion carried. Member Shotzman then motioned to approve the minutes from March 16, 2026, seconded by Member Glick. Motion carried.

Clerk Treasurer Miller – ask the Council to consider discontinuing the Town’s involvement with local non-profits obtaining permission to hold fund raisers (chicken sales) at the Courthouse and return this to the county in light of the County’s recent passing of an Ordinance requiring a permit needing to be obtained to use the Courthouse Lawn. Member Glick made a motion to approve, seconded by Member Bowser. Motion carried.

Town Manager Eagleson – Gave the Council an update on his findings from the meeting he had with IDEM regarding their Community Recycling Grant.

Gave the Council an update on the SR 9 & US 20 project (New DQ). Believes demolition should begin soon.

Advised the Council that he had received a letter of resignation from member Diane Cameron dated March 28, 2026 and presented the Council with Resolution 2026-04-06(A) a Resolution Honoring the Service of Diane Cameron and ask the Council to except the resignation and approve the Resolution. Member Bowser made a motion to approve, seconded by Member Glick. Motion carried.

Department Reports: Received from the Street, Water, and Wastewater.

Supt Sue Detweiler Requested permission to hire Catlyn Helmuth of FirstGen Water Treatment & Design, LLC to assist her in preparing the Town’s NPDES renewal. Member Shotzman made a motion to approve, Member Bowser seconded. Motion carried.

Police Department President Hoover advised the Council that Office Preston Lancour had tendered his resignation. Member Glick made a motion to accept the resignation, Member Bowser seconded. Motion carried.

DLZ Mike Duffy, gave an update of CCMG projects. Present the Town with copies of the completed PER for the Water and Wastewater Departments and informed the Council that the SRF applications had been filed.

Attorney Bill Eberhard /Reagan Penick:

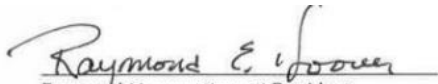

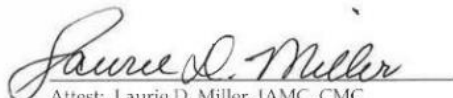
Advised that she would have the bulk water rate ordinance for the Council's next meeting having received no additional comments from the Council's review.
