LaGrange Town Council Meeting

Monday, June 15, 2026

The meeting began with Member Bowser motioning to approve the agenda, Member Shoztman seconded. Motion carried. Member Bowser then motioned to approve the minutes from June 1, 2026, seconded by Member Shoztman. Motion carried.

The advertised public hearing to approve Resolution 2026-06-15A Additional Appropriations for the CEDIT fund in the amount of \$250,000.00. President Hoover asked for any questions from the citizens present and the council members. There being none, a motion was made by Member Glick to approve the resolution. Member Bowser seconded. Motion carried. The meeting then moved to the regular session.

Clerk Treasurer Miller

- Presented May 2026 bank reconciliation records for council review and approval Member Shoztman motioned to approve the records as presented. Member Glick seconded. Motion carried.
- Requested approval for the Clerk and her staff to attend the ILMCT conference in Michigan City July 13-15th, Member Glick motioned to approve the request, seconded by Member Shoztman. Motion carried.

Town Manager Eagleson

- Mark Eagleson would like to have approval to sell inactive police cars via Biddergy Auctions. Member Bowser motioned to approve, Member Shoztman seconded. Motion carried.

Department Reports: Reports were provided by John Marlow, Street Supervisor; Amber Coburn, Cemetery Supervisor; Sue Detweiler, Wastewater Superintendent and Mark Miller, Water Superintendent

Mark Miller presented quotes to purchase a "Tamper with footplate" as follows:

1. Stutzman Power Equipment \$3114.00; 2. Grainger \$3164.46; 3. Northern Tool and Equipment \$ 3247.99. After discussing the need for the equipment by other departments as well, Member Glick motioned approval to make the purchase from Stutzman Power Equipment. Member Bowser seconded. Motion carried.

Richard Snyder requested the council approve an agreement to retire the K9 unit (Lyka) for health reasons. The agreement would transfer liability to the current handler, Christopher Smith. Member Brower motioned to approve the town attorney drafting the agreement, and allowing President Hoover to sign the agreement outside of a regular meeting. Member Shotzman seconded. Motion carried.

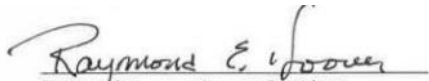

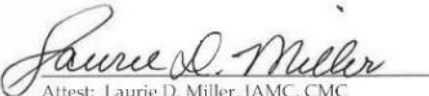
Open Discussion: Noted that former employee James Walter will be returning to full time status as of June 29, 2026
