



Meeting Minutes – May 7, 2012

Opening:

The regular meeting of the LaGrange Town Council met at 7:00 pm, at the LaGrange Town Hall.

Council Members Present: Mark Eagleson , Greg Kenner, Ray Hoover, Richard Greene, Bruce Eagleson, Laurie Miller, Bill Eberhard

Absent: Michael Rowlison

Council Member Richard Greene made a motion to open the meeting with flexibility, Member Bruce Eagleson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Council Member B. Eagleson made a motion to approve minutes from the April 16, 2012 meeting, Member R. Greene seconded the motion. Motion carried.

WASTEWATER - Presented quotes for a new hydro-ranger as follows: Gasvoda - \$1468.00; I. Kruger \$1605.27. Member Ray Hoover made a motion to purchase the equipment from Gasvoda. Member B. Eagleson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Water: Requested permission to attend an AWWA seminar on May 17th at a cost of \$25.00. Member Kenner made a motion to approve the seminar attendance, Member Hoover seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The North Tower was drained for inspection. There was some minor damage due to something being shot at the tower, and the Lakeland Logo needs repaired.

Has been handing out the required CCR Report for the year to all customers.

Inquired about how the dumpstation at the Fairgrounds is handled. It was stated that payment is to be made to the caretakers.

Discussed fire hydrant repairs.

FIRE: Attended the REMC electrical training. Discussed various truck repairs. Gave a report on the Fish Fry.

Provided quotes on a CTC6005 stabilizer. They stabilize vehicles in accidents to make extrication easier. The cost for the equipment is \$6595.00 for now, and will increase to \$8250.00 after June 1st. The Fire Department has raised funds for about ½ of the cost. Member Kenner made a motion to approve purchasing the equipment along with strut jacks at \$675.00. The Town funds will pay 1/2. Member Greene seconded the motion. Motion carried.

POLICE: Also attended the training at REMC.

Reserve Academy is finished for the year.

Marshal Snyder asked the council to consider a raise for Deputy Sprunger. He is second in charge, and is doing very well with the responsibility. Member Hoover asked if they could meet in Executive session to discuss his job performance and review the policy of "Rank" in the department. Atty Eberhard stated that it would be allowed. An executive session was scheduled for May 21, 2012 at 6:30 pm.

Reported that the dept has solved a major fraud case.

Presented a request by Benny Johnson for a carport. Member B. Eagleson made a motion to approve the request, Member Kenner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

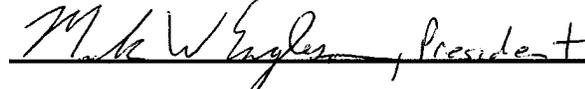
