## **ORDINANCE NO. 2020-10-5( C )**

## AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PUBLIC RECORDS REQUESTS POLICIES AND ESTABLISHING A REQUIRED FORM

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 5-14-3 et seq. sets forth the law concerning access to public records in Indiana; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant lo Ind. Code § 5-14-3-3, the Town of LaGrange ("the Town") may require a request for inspection or copying of public records be in writing or on a form provided by the Town:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 5-14-3-3, the Town may require a requester of public records to make copies of the records on the Town's equipment or the requester's own equipment; and

WHEREAS, it promotes uniformity, transparency, clarity and efficiency to require all public records requests be in writing and on the form attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A and all granted record access be accorded by the requester making copies on the Town's equipment (or the requester's own equipment if the Town lacks the appropriate equipment) at a location designated by the Town.

## **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LAGRANGE, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The above recitals are incorporated by reference.

Section 2. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 5- 14-3-3, the form attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A, which may be amended from time to time by the Town Council, must be fully completed by all individuals or entities requesting access to public records from the Town pursuant to Ind. Code § 5-14-3 et seq.

Section 3. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 5-14-3-3, the Town shall require all individuals or entities requesting access to public records pursuant to Incl. Code §5-14-3 et seq. to make copies of the records in person, on the Town's equipment. When a request for access to public records is granted, the Town will designate the appropriate location where the requester will be able to access and/or make copies of responsive records. The appropriate location will be selected pursuant to the Town Department in control of the records at issue. If the Town lacks the appropriate equipment for copying the responsive records, the requester may use his, her, or its own equipment to make copies, in person at the location designated by the Town. The Town further reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to utilize email and/or fax to fulfill small requests for public records available electronically.

<u>Section 4.</u> Costs, as provided in I.C. 5-14-3-8, shall be reimbursed to the Town by requester at the time of delivery of the records, or if the costs exceed Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$50.00), payment shall be made in advance.

This Ordinance shall be effective October 6, 2020.
