****Resident Concerns****

2. Lisa Beckham was concerned that her water bill was increased along with the other 2 services on her bill. Board explained they is a 5-year plan in place and as our prices go up, we must increase the services the town provides. She was also concerns about her water smelling of chlorine. Andrew stated he will test their water with the next water testing. He also stated that the testing we have done has all came back good and clear. She was also concerned about the paving on her street as well as the road not being blocked off where she felt it need to be for the house fire. Kristie stated that is the fire and EMA not the town.
3. Kristie informed the council and Joe that Greg Moore was inquiring about an alley being closed. Jow stated he does not recall closing that at any time. Suggested that Greg come to a meeting to request it be closed.


