May 6, 2026

Minutes

Barbara called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.

In attendance was Barbara Johnson (president), Arthur Kirtley (council member), Robert Hutchens (council member), Suzan Myers (attorney), Michael Straley III (clerk)

This was followed by the pledge to the flag and the Lord's prayer.

Robert made a motion to approve the minutes from April 1, 2026. Arthur second the motion. Motion carried all in favor.

Robert made a motion to approve the claims. Arthur second the motion. Motion carried all in favor.

Arthur made the motion to approve the BONY transfer. Robert second the motion. Motion carried all in favor.

Arthur made the motion for the water transfer. Barbara seconded the motion. Motion carried all in favor.

Barbara called for council information. There was none.

Barbara called for attorney information. Suzan sent a letter to Pittsburg tank invoking liquidated damage. This is \$1,000 a day which now totals \$365,000. She hasn't heard anything from them.

Suzan read resolution 2026-2 to update the Edit plan. We owed a previous loan of \$40k before we could start paying towards \$150k.

Arthur made a motion to accept resolution 2026-3. Robert seconded the motion. Motion carried all in favor.

Suzan read resolution 2026-3 changing wording on the penalty/shutoff list. Arthur made a motion to accept resolution 2026-3. Robert seconded the motion. Motion carried all in favor.

Barbar called for employee information. There was none.

Barbar called for clerk's information. Michael stated that the CCR report was posted electronically as well as the library, post office, and city building. Anyone wanting a hard copy could request it at the city building.

Michael stated clean up days was May 9th this Saturday and a reminder had been sent to the citizens.

Michael stated that the audit was complete and we had just a few findings. One was we need approval for medical co pay to be allowed to be used not only by employees but their dependents. Robert made a motion to allow medical co pay to be used for dependents as well as employees. Arthur second the motion. Motion was carried all in favor.

Michael stated the auditor manager suggested that we send the customer who is not paying their water bill and does not have sewage hook up to a collection agency. Suzan stated that it would probably cost just as much to do that as what would be received. She suggested she send a letter to the customer and see if that would get them to pay. Michael stated he would send the information to Suzan tomorrow with the information.

Michael stated he needed approval to transfer money from FEMA to Edit. This was the money borrowed for the Fire radios. We did not get the full amount back as the town had to match 5% of the grant.

Robert made a motion to approve the transfer from FEMA to Edit. Arthur seconded the motion. The motion carried all in favor.

Michael stated we had received one quote for the sign and we were waiting for one more. We should have something for the June meeting.

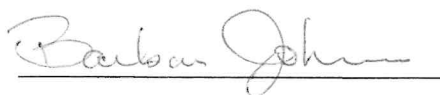

Barbara called for old business. There was none.

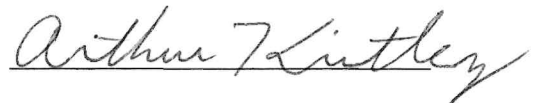
Barbara called for new business. There was none.

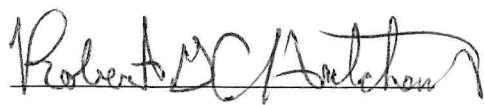
Arthur made a motion to adjourn. Robert seconded the motion. Motion carried all in favor.
