
A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR NONPAYMENT OF WATER AND SEWAGE BILLS FOR THE TOWN OF LYNN, INDIANA

WHEREAS, this resolution establishing procedures for the nonpayment of Town of Lynn Water and Sewage Bills shall become effective on the 6th day of May 2026. The purpose of this resolution is to delineate the procedures required when payment of town of Lynn Water and Sewage bills are past due.


NOW, THEREFORE, the town council of Lynn Indiana states that the following procedures shall be adopted concerning nonpayment of Town of Lynn Water and Sewage bills.

- (1) Bills of water and sewage will be sent monthly to all users, and the bills must be paid online, in the night drop, mailed, or in person to the office of the Clerk-Treasurer. If a bill is not paid for 15 days after it is due, a late charge penalty of 10% of the bill shall be added to the balance due.
- (2) If a bill is not paid for 60 days after it is due, the Clerk-Treasurer shall send a service disconnect letter via USPS first class mail on the 16th of the month. If the 16th shall fall on a weekend or holiday then the letter will be sent on the following business day stating that if the total past due bill and all late charges are not paid in full by the 25th of each month then the Town of Lynn can disconnect water services to the user.
- (3) Shall water services be disconnected for nonpayment, the Town of Lynn shall have 48 hours to reconnect water service to the user once the total past due bill and all late charges which includes a reconnect fee of \$50.00 has been paid.


