Attorney Robbins states that our request for bids was advertised twice and four (4) sealed bids have been received. Attorney Robbins opens the bids.


All Star Paving	\$605,331.00

Milestone	\$873,794.75



Attorney Robbins states that the council can award the bid to the lowest bidder contingent on review by the Attorney and PW Supt. McCauslin to confirm that the bid is responsive. Or the council can direct Attorney Robbins and PW Supt. McCauslin to review the bids and determine the lowest responsive bid and bring a recommendation to the April 6th council meeting. PW Supt. McCauslin notes we are still waiting on confirmation from the State on the Community Crossing Matching Grant awards. Attorney Robbins notes the council must accept the lowest, responsive bid or reject all bids and start over.
