MEETING MINUTES

Town Council President John Perrin opened the meeting at 5:00 p.m. with the pledge to the American flag. Council members present were John Perrin, John Schilawski, Chad Waltz, John Purdie and Dennis Combs. Also present were Attorney Lee Robbins, Clerk-Treasurer Angela DeVoss and Administrator Maribeth Alspach. Council President John Perrin offered the opening prayer.

OLD BUSINESS

2022 Manhole Rehabilitation Contract, Transfer

At our previous council meeting Utility Supervisor Gillock presented that he had found additional amounts owed to Wessler on a project from last year that had already closed out. This meeting serves to provide more information as to where money can be moved if we are to proceed with this project his year. Utility Supervisor Gillock presents that he found money that was already in his budget in a few different areas to transfer. He provides information regarding the contract totaling \$105,554.80. There were some shortfalls because of errors on the engineering side from last year. This project will complete every manhole that's been inspected and listed as priority 1s and priority 2s. Priority 3s should be reinspected in three years. Councilman Purdie moves to approve the transfer of funds presented in the memo and is seconded by Councilman Schilawski. **Vote 5 affirmative.** Councilman Purdie moves to approve the contract and is seconded by Councilman Waltz. **Vote 5 affirmative.**

NEW BUSINESS

Plan Commission


Council President John Purdie presents that they need 7 on the Plan Commission. The Town received a letter of interest from Chris Mazzarella, who is an Independent, requesting to be appointed. Mazzarella is the president of the HOA at Country Gate, is very involved and knowledgeable. Councilman Schilawski moves to appoint Chris Mazzarella to the Plan Commission and is seconded by Councilman Combs. **Vote 5 affirmative.**


Tot Park
