HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:

The only time the Town of New Whiteland will be affected by a holiday, is if the holiday falls on a Wednesday, Thursday or a Friday. For 2023, only Thanksgiving will be affected. Which means trash pick up will be one day delayed for Thursday and Friday customers. Wednesday customers will be picked up on Wednesday, November 22nd.

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

FREQUENCY

Trash will be picked up one time per week.
Trash must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. in
a Best Way container

LIMIT

There is a 95-gallon limit. Please make
sure all waste is inside the provided
tote. Extra bags can be set out with your
regular trash on your regular trash day
with an extra bag sticker. Extra bag
stickers be purchased for \$.75 each
at the New Whiteland Town Hall.

HEAVY TRASH

Heavy trash pick up will be the first pick up
day of every month on your regular trash
day. Heavy trash can include furniture,
carpeting (no larger than 4 X 4 pieces) and
other flooring scraps (no asbestos), metal
appliances.

Metal appliances with Freon such as
refrigerators, freezers or air conditioners
MUST have a certification from a licensed
technician verifying that all freon has been
removed before placing curbside.

Christmas trees can be placed curbside
during heavy trash week. Tree limbs may
be set out provided they are tied in
bundles not exceeding 4 feet in length and
3 feet in girth.
Heavy trash does not include extra bags,
construction or demolition debris, televisions,
computers, electronics or appliances
containing freon.

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Recyclables are on the same schedule
as your regular trash pickup and will be
the first pick up of every month. **ALL
RECYCLABLES MUST FIT IN THE
DESIGNATED CART.**

If a holiday falls on or before your pickup
day, trash and recycling will be picked up
one day later than scheduled.

WHAT SHOULD BE PLACED IN YOUR RECYCLING CART:

Aluminum/Bi-Metal Beverage Cans
Please crush.

Steel Food Cans

Rinse and remove all labels. If possible,
remove the bottom and flatten the can by
stepping on it. For safety reasons, do not
put lids in your recycling cart.

Plastics #1 through #7
Remove cap and rings. Rinse and flatten.
Labels need not be removed. This
includes soda pop bottles, milk jugs,
laundry products and water bottles.

Newspaper

This includes newsprint, glossy coupons
and brown paper bags, but does not
include anything that has staples or a
binding.

WHAT SHOULD NOT BE PLACED IN YOUR RECYCLING CART:

Items that should not be placed in your
recycling cart include trash, plastic bags,
window panes, styrofoam, light bulbs,
glassware, electronics, grass, leaves
or other yard waste.
