

CURBSIDE RECYCLING COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Instead of putting glass, newspaper, beverage cans, plastic and steel food cans in the garbage, simply follow the preparation procedures provided and place those items in your recycling cart at the street.

WHAT SHOULD BE PLACED IN YOUR RECYCLING CART

Aluminum / Bi-metal Beverage Cans

Please crush.

Steel Food Cans

Rinse and remove all labels. If possible, remove the bottom and flatten the can by stepping on it. For safety reasons, do not put lids in your recycling cart.

Plastics #1 through #7

Remove cap and rings; rinse and flatten. Labels need not be removed. This includes soda pop bottles, milk jugs, laundry products and water bottles.

Newspaper

This includes newsprint, glossy coupons and brown paper bags, but does NOT include anything that has staples or a binding. Please bag or bundle papers for easier handling.

WHAT SHOULD NOT BE PLACED IN YOUR RECYCLING CART

- Motor oil
- Motor oil containers
- Rubbish
- Plastic bags
- Window panes, light bulbs, ceramic, or drinking glasses
- Grass, leaves or other yard waste
- Phone books, magazines, envelopes

TRASH

Frequency

Trash will be picked up one time per week. Trash must be at curbside by **7:00 A.M.** on your pickup day.

Limit

There is a 95 gallon limit. Please make sure all waste is inside the provided tote.

Heavy Trash

Heavy trash will be the first pick up of every month. It will be picked up on your regular trash day along with your trash tote. Heavy trash can include furniture, carpeting (no larger than 4 x 4 pieces) and other flooring scraps (that do not contain asbestos), metal appliances (**except ones containing Freon such as refrigerators, freezers, or air conditioners**). Extra bags that are not set out during the normal heavy trash pick up will require an extra bag sticker. These stickers can be purchased for .75 cents at the New Whiteland Town Hall.

HEAVY TRASH DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY DEBRIS FROM CONSTRUCTION OR DEMOLITIONS, TELEVISIONS, COMPUTERS, OR ELECTRONICS.

TREE LIMBS MAY BE SET OUT PROVIDED THEY ARE TIED IN BUNDLES NOT EXCEEDING 4 FEET IN LENGTH AND 3 FEET IN GIRTH.

Freon Containing Appliances

Any appliances containing freon (such as freezers, refrigerators, and air conditioners) must have a certification tag from a licensed technician verifying that all freon has been removed.

RECYCLING

Frequency

Recyclables are on the same schedule as your regular trash pickup and will be the first pick up of every month.

HOLIDAY WEEK PICKUP SCHEDULE

If a holiday falls on or before your pickup day, trash and recycling will be picked up one day later than scheduled.

Example: Thanksgiving will fall on a Thursday, therefore Thursday trash and recycling will be picked up on Friday, and Friday trash and recycling will be picked up on Saturday. Wednesday trash and recycling pickup will not be affected.
