

TOWN OF REDKEY
SALARY ORDINANCE 2022-02
January 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023

SECTION 1:

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Redkey, that the Town positions and the salaries and wages for said positions shall be as follows and payable as scheduled below, beginning the first pay period in January 2023:

TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERS (5)

The Town Council Members shall each receive \$432.84 per quarter, not to exceed \$1,731.36 from the General Fund. Total for the year not to exceed \$8,656.80.

CLERK-TREASURER:

The Clerk-Treasurer shall receive:

- \$19,584.79 from the General Fund
- \$ 9,792.41 from the Water Operating Fund
- \$ 9,792.41 from the Sewage Operating Fund

Total salary paid to the Clerk-Treasurer shall not exceed \$39,169.61.

TOWN MARSHAL:

The Town Marshal shall receive \$44,082.03 from the General Fund

Total Salary paid to the Town Marshal shall not exceed \$44,082.03.

DEPUTY MARSHAL:

The salary of part-time Deputy Marshal will receive \$19.00 per hour, not to exceed 20 hours per week for up to two part-time officers, for a total not to exceed \$39,520.00.

UTILITIES WORKER:

The Utilities Worker shall receive:

- Up to \$12,111.57 from the Motor Vehicle Highway Fund
- Up to \$12,111.57 from the Water Operating Fund
- Up to \$12,111.57 from the Sewage Operating Fund

Total salary paid to the Utilities Worker shall not exceed \$36,334.71, after 90 days employment with the Town of Redkey. The Redkey Town Council has the right to set the Salary of a Utilities Worker at their discretion but not to exceed \$36,334.71.

WATER OPERATOR:

The Water Operator shall receive \$220.41 per week for operation of the Redkey Water Plant.

WASTEWATER OPERATOR:

The Wastewater Operator shall receive:

- \$ 5,037.94 from Motor Vehicle Highway Fund

Total salary paid to the Wastewater Superintendent shall not exceed \$41,563.07.

OFFICE ASSISTANT:

The Office Assistant shall receive:

\$10,329.48 from General Fund

\$10,329.48 from Water Operating

\$10,329.48 from Sewage Operating

The Office Assistant shall be paid an hourly rate of \$16.46 per hour, not to exceed \$30,988.44.

PART-TIME LABORER:

Part-Time Laborer shall receive \$13.18 to \$16.46 per hour, as set by the Redkey Town Council, payable from the:

Motor Vehicle Highway Fund

Water Operating Fund

Sewage Operating Fund

Payment for part-time laborer shall be made from the appropriate fund based upon duties performed.

SECTION II:

The Town Council Members shall be paid at the end of each quarter except for the last quarter.

Payment for the last quarter shall be made the first payroll in December.

SECTION III:

The Water and Wastewater Operators shall receive a one-time payment in the amount of \$500.00 to be added to their salary after successfully completing water and/or wastewater certification. The additional \$500.00 will be paid the first pay period in December.

SECTION IV:

Full time employees and the Clerk-Treasurer shall be eligible for health insurance provided by the Town.

SECTION V:

Except as noted, said employees and elected positions shall be paid on a weekly basis. Each pay period shall end on Thursday. Paychecks shall be issued on Friday. No exceptions unless holiday falls on Friday.

SECTION VI:

This Ordinance shall be effective with the first pay period in January 2023 through December 31, 2023.

This Ordinance was duly passed in regular session of the Town Board of the Town of Redkey, Jay County Indiana, on this 20th day of October, 2022




