**ORDINANCE ADDRESSING REGULATION OF ALLEYS**

**ORDINANCE 2017- 5 AMMENDS ORDINANCE 2011-3 ADDRESSING  
REGULATION OF ALLEYS IN THE TOWN OF REDKEY**

WHEREAS, the Town of Redkey, Indiana has determined that public safety warrants the need for regulations with regard to use of alleyways located within the corporate boundaries of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Redkey, Indiana sets forth regulations with regard to the use of alleyways located in the Town.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Redkey, Indiana that:

- I. For the purpose of the Ordinance, the following definition shall apply unless the context of the Ordinance clearly indicates or requires a different meaning;

Alley: a public thorough fare which affords only secondary means of vehicular access to abutting property and is not over 20 feet in width.

- II. No person shall park, store or permit to be parked or stored, any automobile, automobile trailer, boat trailer and/or house trailer or semi trailer motor vehicle in any alley.

- III. No person shall stop, store or park an automobile within an alley or street in such position as to block the driveway entrance to any abutting property.

- IV. No person shall cause or permit any structure or obstruction to be placed in, hanging over or authorize encroach on an alley, whether such obstruction be a permanent structure, or temporary obstruction, including, but not limited to, basketball and/or other sport goals, signs, mulch, dirt or other piles of landscaping or other materials.

- V. Any person found in violation of any of these provisions may be fined in an amount not to exceed \$2500.00 upon conviction.

- VI. This ordinances shall be effective ten (10) days after publication of the ordinance.
