## ORDINANCE 2010-4

## FIREWORKS ORDINANCE Note; Amends Ordinance 2009-10

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Redkey, Indiana has adopted a ordinance regulating the use of consumer fireworks within the corporate boundaries of the Town of Redkey Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Redkey, Indiana desires to assess a fine for those individuals who use and/or ignite any consumer fireworks inside the corporate boundaries of the Town during times other than permitted times.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDKEY, INDIANA:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 2009-10 shall be amended to state as follows:

No person (consumer) shall use and/or ignite any consumer fireworks inside the corporate boundaries of the Town during times other than:

- A. Between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and two hours after sunset on June 29th, June 30, July 1, July 5, July 6, July 7, July 8 and July 9;
  - B. Between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight on July 4; and
- C. Between the hours of 10:00 a.m. on December 31, and 1:00 a.m. on January 1.

Any person who violates this section shall be fined the sum of \$50.00 for the first violation, the sum of \$75.00 for the second violation and the sum of \$100.00 for the third and each violation thereafter.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
