ORDINANCE 2003-3

TOWN OF REDKEY, INDIANA

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF OVERSIZED VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF REDKEY, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF
TOWN OF REDKEY, JAY COUNTY, INDIANA

THAT:

SECTION I: For the purpose of this Ordinance the term oversized vehicle shall be construed to mean and include any automobile, truck, trailer, wagon machine and all conveyances on wheels in or upon which a person or thing is carried and which exceeds twenty-one (21) feet in length or seven (7) feet in width. This definition shall not apply to any oversized vehicle which is designed and used to pick up, transport or deliver public passangers.

SECTION II: A person may not stop, park or leave standing an attended or unattended oversized vehicle on any highway, street, alley within the corporate limits of the Town of Redkey, Indiana for any continuous period of time longer than two (2) hours.

SECTION III: A person may not stop, park, or leave standing an attended or unattended oversized vehicle with its engine running at any location within the corporate limits of the Town of Redkey, Indiana for any continuous period of time longer than one (1) hour.

SECTION IV: Any vehicle found parked within the corporate limits of the Town of Redkey, Indiana in violation of this ordinance is subject to removal by the Police Department or their designated agents and the owner of any such vehicle so removed shall be required to pay all moving and storage fees before such vehicle shall be released to said owner. Said moving and storage charges shall be in addition to any other penalty which may be levied under this ordinance.

SECTION V: Any person found to have violated this Ordinance shall be subject to fine of not less than two hundred, fifty dollars (\$250) nor more than two thousand, five hundred dollars (\$2,500). In addition, each twenty four (24) hour period during which any violation of this ordinance occurs or continues shall constitute a separate and distinct violation.

ORDINANCE ON TOWN UTILITIES POLICIES
Amendment to 2008-7

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDKEY, INDIANA THAT:

Ordinance 2008-7 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 2: Now reads: Meters shall be read from the 19th to the 22nd day of each month.

Shall be amended to read: **Meters shall be read from the 18th to the 20th day of each month.**

Section 5: Now reads: All customers who request utility service shall be required to pay a deposit. Said deposit shall be the sum of One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$125.00). Deposits shall be paid in full prior to utility services being provided to the customer.

Section 5(A) shall be added: **Customers will be eligible for a refund of a deposit made after one(1) year providing the customer pays no late fees. Customer must have a consecutive twelve month period in which no late fees are paid.**

Section 5(B) shall be added: **If a customer's account becomes delinquent and water service disconnected due to non payment, then said customer having received a deposit refund, will be required to make a new deposit.**

Section 11: Now reads: Customers may request one disconnection of water service one time per year at no charge. Each additional requested disconnection of service shall be at the charge of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).

Shall be amended to read: **Customers may request one disconnection of water service one time per year at no charge. Each additional request for disconnection of water service shall be at the charge of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). However if the customer requests disconnection of water for the purpose of making repairs, no charge will be made.**

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2012-6
ADMENTMENT TO ORDINANCE NUMBER 2009-12
AN ORDINANCE AS TO TRASH TOTERS IN THE
TOWN OF REDKEY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Redkey, Indiana has determined there is a need to adopt regulations addressing toters provided by the Town of Redkey for the collection of trash and rubbish;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDKEY, INDIANA THAT:

Section 1. All residents and businesses should place their trash toter at the street curb or alley where their trash is collected no earlier than 7:00 a.m. of the evening before the day of collection.

Section 2. All residents and businesses shall have their trash toters removed from the street curb or alley no later than 7:00 a.m. on the day after collection.

Section 3. All residents and businesses who have their trash toters out on the street curb or alley during times not permitted, shall be assessed a fine in the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). Each day in which the trash toter remains on the street curb or alley in violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 4. This ordinance does not apply in situations where trash cannot be collected by the Town of Redkey's trash removal contractor due to weather related conditions, construction and other factors that prevent the contractor from collecting the trash during its normal route days and times.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective ten (10) days after publication.
