

TOWN OF REDKEY, INDIANA
ORDINANCE 2015-3

An Ordinance Prohibiting Plantings on the Town Right of Way

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD, OF THE TOWN OF REDKEY, JAY
COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

(A) Unless otherwise allowed by permit as stated in division (C) below, it shall be violation of this section to insert, plant or maintain the following in any public rights-of-way in the Town of Redkey:

- (1) Any tree, shrub or bush over 12 inches in height;
- (2) Any other plant life over 12 inches tall; and
- (3) Any improvement, including without limitation, any improvement designed to assist the growth of any plant life.

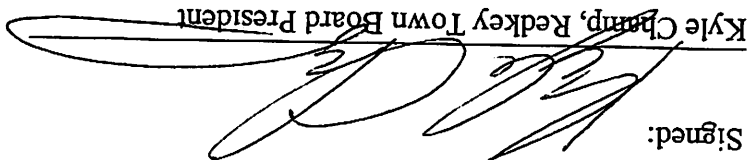
(B) Division (A) above shall not be construed to prohibit the insertion, planting or maintenance of grass or plant life less than 12 inches tall in the town's rights-of-way.

(C) In the event a citizen of the Town of Redkey desires to plant a tree, shrub, or bush in the town's rights-of-way, the citizen must:

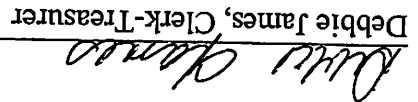
- (1) Attend a Town Board meeting to gain approval before planting the tree, shrub or bush.
- (D) Any growth or improvement found in violation of this Ordinance shall be removed from the town's right of way at the property owner's expense.
