## ORDINANCE NO. 1-2010

## PARKING REGULATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Roann Town Board of Wabash County, Indiana, that a need now exists for the regulation of parking within the limits of the Town of Roann in order to promote the safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Roann.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Roann, Indiana, as follows:

- **Section 1. Specific Areas Where Parking is Prohibited**: Parking of a motorized or non-motorized vehicle on the west side of Chippewa Street between Pike Street and Adams Street is prohibited.
- **Section 2.** Responsible Parties for Parking Violation: The registered owner or owners of a vehicle parked or stopped in violation of this ordinance, and occupants of said vehicle, whether or not they shall be the registered owner or owners of such vehicle, shall be presumed to be the person or persons who caused such vehicle to be unlawfully parked or stopped, and shall be liable for violations of this ordinance.
- **Section 3. Notice of Violation**: Notice of a violation shall be given by attaching a uniform traffic citation to the vehicle or by personal service upon the owner or owners of such vehicle or the occupants thereof.
- **Section 4. Fines**: Any person, registered owner or owners, or occupants of a vehicle, in violation of this ordinance, shall be fined Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). Such fine or fines shall be paid to the Clerk of the Town of Roann within twenty-four (24) hours, excluding intervening Saturdays, Sundays or holidays. In the event such fine or fines are not paid to the Clerk of the Town of Roann within twenty-four (24) hours, excluding intervening Saturdays, Sundays or holidays, court costs, as established by any court of competent jurisdiction, shall be added to said fine or fines.
