Rodney distributed a use of force report; no injuries were reported and subject was arrested. Rodney reported seven properties have been issued mowing notice. Rodney and Chad will invite the 411 North Virginia Street property owner to attend a meeting to discuss plans for the Town to assist with the cost of a dumpster if the owner has labor for clean-up. The cost of the dumpster would be filed against the property.

Notice was given to the Town Council of the resignation of Shelly Gregg from the Pool Advisory and Park Boards.

Mike reviewed the Economic Development Commission ordinance and stated that it fits within the State Statute. The Commission has three vacancies and members are appointed by the President, the Town Council nad the County Commission with the terms staggered.
