RESIDENTS' COMMENTS, COMPLAINTS AND CONCERNS:

FIRE DEPARTMENT: Kevin Etmeier reported that they had 2 cornfield fires, during the time we were having the drought, a wreck with a fatality at the Intersection of 59 & 58. Their Halloween party was good but not as good as last year, probably due to the highway being closed for repairs & paving. They are having their jaws of life worked on. Landon Rich is the new Jr. Volunteer that is having some issues with the fatality.

NEW BUSINESS: Ralph stated that he had contacted Jay Yagle to get pictures of the backhoe, blade and the Water & Sewer Truck F-150, for selling them at Jay's Auction Service.

BUSINESS NOT ON THE AGENDA: Jeremy stated that he had received several complaints about the noise from Wagler's. Asking for any suggestions? He asked if there was an Ordinance for this. Ralph stated he would ask his wife Joan, who works for Larry, to come to a meeting with the board to discuss the issues. Asking about the noise, and that Larry is claiming a Homestead credit for a home he does not live in.
