

TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

November 15, 2025

The November meeting opened with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 p.m. in the Stilesville Town Hall with all Town Board members present. The Fire Chief, the Town Attorney, and the Town Marshal were in attendance, the Wastewater Treatment Operator was excused for the meeting. A motion was made and seconded to accept the previous month's minutes as written (3-0).

NEW BUSINESS

The Fire Chief presented the Fire Dept Report and explained the upcoming work INDOT had planned for the intersection of county road 200 and US 40. The Town Marshal gave the monthly police report, updated the board on the status of Reserve Officer Musson's training progress, and announced that the firearm and ammunition purchase had been made to equip Officer Musson. Jerry Chandler expressed concern for the safety of local children after observing stop arm violations being committed by drivers during the morning school bus pick-ups on US 40. The Town Marshal thanked him and said he would contact the School Resource officers as well as increase the Town's patrol efforts during the discussed timeframe. Annual Nepotism statements were presented to the board and Clerk/Treasurer for signing, and the days for the 2026 Town Board meetings were discussed in order that the meeting schedule could be presented in December.

OLD BUSINESS

A complaint was received by a Board member that there may be an unauthorized above ground sewer line located behind the house located at 6214 W. US Hwy 40.
