

**TOWN COUNCIL MEETING****July 8, 2026**

The July meeting opened with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 p.m. in the Stilesville Town Hall with two Town Board members present, Ernest Newby was excused. The Fire Chief, and the Town Marshal, and Town Attorney were in attendance, the Wastewater Treatment Operator was excused for the meeting. A motion was made and seconded to accept the previous month's minutes as written (2-0).

**NEW BUSINESS**

The Fire Chief presented the Fire Dept Report and announced that the Fire Dept acquired an additional support vehicle for their operations and had applied for a grant for two new tornado sirens for the Township. The Town Marshal gave the monthly police report and asked for permission to switch over from Firstnet to another carrier for better connectivity, if the new carrier was within \$15 of the old one. Barbara Webster made a motion to approve the transition with those terms, and the motion passed (2-0). Barbara Webster made a motion to hold the 2027 Budget Hearing on August 12, 2026, at 6:30 pm and the 2027 Budget Adoption on September 9, 2026, at 6:30 pm, Both passed (2-0).

**OLD BUSINESS**

Rosalie Turnbull asked the board if the Music in the Park program details could be delayed until the August meeting to allow more time to get things together due to difficulties with scheduling around summer vacations. Barbara Webster asked her to keep the board updated at the August meeting.

**Miscellaneous Business**

Jacob Hammond asked the status of the North St. drainage issue, and was referred to the Town Attorney, who informed him that the materials submitted were still under review.

**CLAIMS**

A motion to pay the claims for the month was made and seconded and passed (2-0).

**Vouchers dated from 7/1-7/31/2026 in the Voucher Register were reviewed & approved by the Town Board Members for \$10,479.50. A motion to adjourn carried (2-0).**
