

TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**June 10, 2026**

The June meeting opened with an additional appropriations budget hearing at 6:30 PM, during which a motion was made to accept the additional appropriations as written, then the pledge to the flag at 7:00 p.m. in the Stilesville Town Hall with all Town Board members present. The Fire Chief, and the Town Marshal, and Town Attorney were in attendance, the Wastewater Treatment Operator was excused for the meeting. A motion was made and seconded to accept the previous month's minutes as written (3-0).

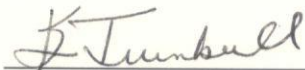
NEW BUSINESS

The Fire Chief presented the Fire Dept Report and announced that the Fire Dept received approval for a 2024 grant and would be purchasing five-inch water hose for the Dept. The Town Marshal gave the police Report for the month. Barbara Webster announced that the Town Clean-up Day would be running on Saturday June 13th from 10:00 AM until 4:00 PM. Zac Hammond asked for an update on the status of the street drainage on North Street, to which Kevin Turnbull provided an update. Zac then asked the Board and Town Marshal to look into the property condition at 6185 North Street, and the four wheelers which are being ridden in town with the drivers causing property damage in two locations. A request for permission to use the Town Park was submitted to the Board for a Music in the Park Evening on July 24th by Rosalie Turnbull. She gave tentative details, and the Board made a motion to grant permission and passed (3-0) and Barbara Webster asked Rosalie to update the Board with set details at the July Board meeting.
